

Woodlands Theme Overview



Communication & Interaction/Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will have a great focus on our feelings. We will use the book The Colour Monster to initially to spark discussion about the different ways people can feel and react to situations. The children will use role play to demonstrate how different emotions might look in our body and what we can do when we feel sad or angry. To support our communication, the children will use family pictures to share and engage with the class. The children will also communicate their likes and dislikes through drawings and this will also link with our RE topic of belonging. On some afternoons Squirrels class will have structured play to encourage their interaction with eachother

Scientific Technologies/Understanding the World

In Science, the children will be learning all about their own bodies. We will look at the different parts of the body and label. The children will start to look at the different organs and their purpose. We will learn about the 5 senses by taking a practical approach. In our cooking lessons the children will practice their chopping and grating skills. For Art this term, we will be drawing self-portraits. The children will use different mediums such as water colours, sketching and pen work to create various versions of themselves. In History, Squirrels class will be exploring the Northampton Shoe Industry. We will think about our own shoes, what they were like in the past and will look at the building where the shoes were made.

English and Maths

This term in Maths, Squirrel class will be learning about place value and calculations. We will be first foussing on counting on by filling in missing number tracks. Later in the term we will introduce adding and subtracting by giving children new methods to support their calculations.

As part of our English, we will be using books to inspire writing. We will be using the 'talk for writing' approach to immerse children in the story 'The Love Monster'. The children will use drama and role play to think about the characters and they will create their own version on the story. We will also start to use comprehension questions but supporting the children through visuals.
