

Woodlands Theme Overview



Communication & Interaction/Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term, we will learn how to ask and order food in a café. We will role play reading a menu and having confidence to ask what they want through their preferred means of communication. In school, we will be using our English topic as a driver for our life skills. We will be learning how to read instructions and recipes. In PSHE, we will focus on goals and dreams and how to achieve them. We will think about how we are all special and how we all have little things we want to achieve.

Scientific Technologies/Understanding the World

In Science, we will be learning about the different seasons and the weather that typically come with each. We will also become super scientists as we conduct several experiments, learning how to make accurate predictions and observations. We will learn how to follow instructions in order to experiment correctly.

In Geography we are going to be transported to the top of the world and learning about the Arctic. We will think about how their climate is different to ours by using sensory exploration. We will then think about the animals that may live there and why they are suited to their environment.

Our art focus will be on collage. We will use famous artists as inspiration as we create our own season collage.

English and Maths

Our English topic this term will be focussed around non-fiction writing. We will bring back elements from our last term of work and recreate it as an instructional text. We will explore instructions by following them and reading them within cooking and art lessons. We will also be creating our own instructions by innovating the text we will learn as a class.

Maths this term will take us back to place value but this time looking at one more and one less than a number. This will then lead us into adding within the ones column and then for some children adding across 10. Towards the end of the term we will introduce position and direction using the terms left, right, half turn and full turn.
