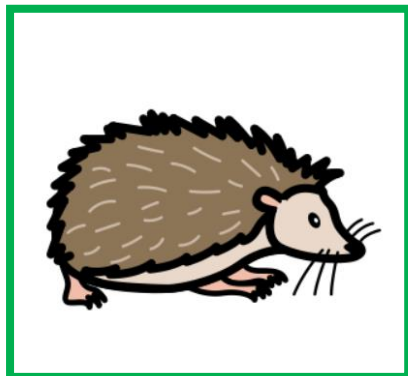




Woodlands Theme Overview

Communication — To be confident communicators in their own form of communication.

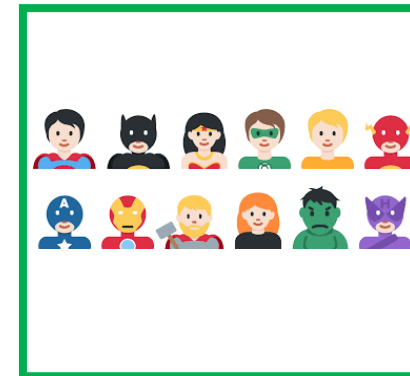
Inclusion — To experience opportunities that develop a strong sense of belonging whilst embracing diversity and individuality.

Communication & Interaction/Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In Hedgehog class, we will be talking a lot about the Superheroes, what they do and how they rescue people from baddies.

Hedgehog class will be continuing to learn about how we can resolve conflict when playing with our friends and how we can play and share well together.

We will be looking at dangers in the environment and when out and about and what we should do and how we should stay safe.

Scientific Technologies/Understanding the World

Hedgehog class will looking different vegetables and fruit, we will be tasting them and making them into Superheroes. We will be thinking about different insects, where they live and what they look like.

Hedgehog class will also be looking at growing things, what changes and what plants, fruit and vegetables need to grow.

English and Maths

Hedgehog class will be looking closely at the book 'Shhh! We have a plan'. We will be immersing ourselves in this book, looking at the main characters, setting and verbally retelling the story to the class. We will also be looking to change parts of the story to make our own stories. We will also be reading lots of other stories. Looking at rhyming words, ordering the stories, writing sentences about the stories and describing characters in the books.

In Maths, Hedgehog class will be looking at early multiplication and division and simple fractions of numbers and shapes.
