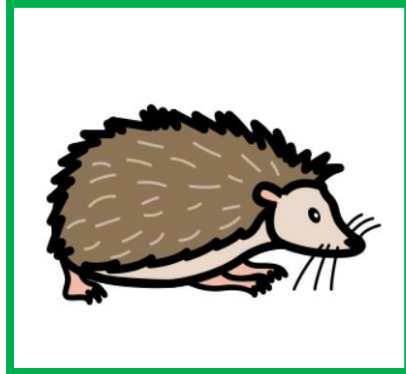




## Woodlands Theme Overview

Hedgehog class will be going to look at different buildings around Northampton, looking at what they are built with and what they look like. We will also be going to the forest and parks to build our own houses, as well as building houses like the Three Little Pigs.



## Woodlands Theme Overview

### Communication & Interaction/Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In Hedgehog class, we will be talking a lot about different buildings, what features we can see, what is the same and what is different about them.

Hedgehog class will be using our imaginations to play with our friends using different equipment and toys. We will be sharing and taking turns and making sure things are fair when we are playing. We will also be using our words to describe what we do and what we do when we are building different structures.

### Scientific Technologies/Understanding the World

Hedgehog class will looking their own homes and different building around the world and what they are used for. We will be looking at and naming the different features of these building.

Hedgehog class will be looking at the different materials we use to build with and why we use them. We will be carrying out tests on different materials to find out what is the best material to build with.

### English and Maths

Hedgehog class will be looking closely at the story of 'The Three Little Pigs', we will be acting out the story, looking closely at the characters and making up our own 5 sentence story. Then we will change the story to make our own version of 'The Three Little ...'. We will also be reading different books about building things, what a building site looks like and what vehicles and tools we use.

In Maths, Hedgehog class will be adding and subtracting with numbers to 20 and for some beyond 20. We will be using number lines, 100 squares, counters and other equipment to help us. We will also be looking at position and direction, using Bee Bots to instruct them where to go and when and where to turn.
