## **Woodlands Theme Overview**



### Communication & Interaction/Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will continue to explore and develop their communication and friendship skills through a range of activities including games, role plays, hot seating, PSHE sessions and interoception sessions. Through our new topic 'Let's build' we will be looking at the qualities of perseverance to overcome obstacles and how we can honestly evaluate our own and others work honestly and without any emotional barriers.

#### Scientific Technologies/Understanding the World

This term Badgers class will explore the areas of DT, History and Science. As part of History we will be looking at how buildings and in particular homes, have changed over time, comparing our own homes to those of the past and exploring the reasons behind their change.

Within DT the children will be working with a range of materials to produce 3D models including a shoe box room as well as using photography to capture and record ideas.

## **English and Maths**

Maths: Within maths we will be focusing on Number and place value, calculation, money and position & direction. Through calculation we will be developing our understanding of multiplication and division whilst continuing to extend our expertise at using place value to aid addition and subtraction. Through money we will looking at giving exact amounts through the least amount of coins and giving change, alongside solving word problems.

English: This term we will continue to develop both their oral and written communication. We will be developing comprehension skills through a range of texts, looking at searching texts for information as well as developing our predicting skills. We will further develop our use of descriptive language when writing about settings alongside using more formal language for instruction writing.
