Termly curriculum newsletter– Termlet 5

This term we will start by reading Jack and the Beanstalk. We will focus on story structurebeginning, middle and end, and develop our understanding of characters and settings. Following on from last term where we began to learn about Spring, we will continue to develop our understanding of how things grow and change. We will be planting beans and seeds and look at life cycles of plants and animals. We will also be learning about how we have changed, more information to follow soon!!

In Maths, we will be measuring the length and weight of beanstalks, flowers and vegetables, sharing amounts, exploring teen numbers and coins and learning about addition.

In Writing, we are writing full sentences ensuring that we have spaces between our words and use our Phonics skills to spell words. We are encouraging the children's independence by saying a sentence and asking the children to have a go at writing it on their own.

We are having a very creative few weeks – the children will be making their own superhero masks and their own 'Supertato'! In Science, we will be carrying out ice investigations and seeing how we
