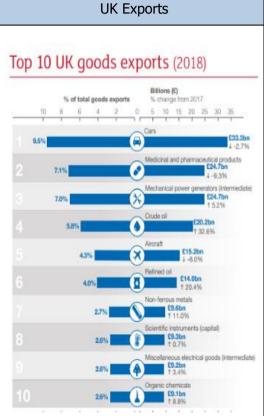
Global Trade – Knowledge Organiser Year 6 Spring 2
