Class 13/14, Year 6, Term 4— How important is trade to the United Kingdom?



Our prime learning challenge this term is: *How important is trade to the United Kingdom?* As **Geographers**, the children will find out about how goods and services are traded around the world. They will explore the UK's trade links today and in the past and why Fairtrade is important in the global market. As **Readers**, we will be continuing to read a range of text types to improve our knowledge of vocabulary. As **Writers**, we will be writing a suspense story based on *A Monster Calls*, and a mystery piece based on *The Nowhere Emporium*.

In other areas of the curriculum, as **Mathematicians**, the children will be continuing to build their arithmetic skills and apply them to reasoning problems. As **Scientists**, the children will learn about how light travels, how shadows are formed and how light is used to help people.

In **RE**, the children are exploring the question: Does it matter what we believe about creation? In **French**, the children are describing clothes. In **Computing**, we will be continuing to learn about internet safety and practicing touch typing. Our **PSHE** focus this term is 'Healthy Me'. In **PE**, the children will be completing a unit of flag football.

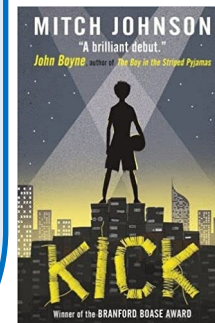

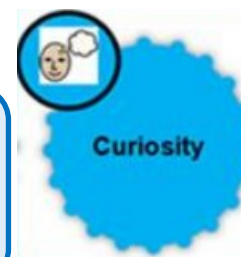
Our class reader this term is 'Kick'.
